The Right Honourable R. B. Bennett, Ottawa, Canada,

Sir:

It is of great interest we read of the possible stabilization of silver through the adoption of the "super-bank of the Empire"using the new monetary unit the 'Rex' as suggested and outlined by J. F. Darling.

We all expect great things of our new Premier, and although the present day problems offer more obstacles than usual to cope with, which have been brought about by the depreciation and debasement of Silver, there is a golden opportunity to be taken advantage of. That of transforming Canada from a land of insolvency, unemployment, breeding place of Bolshevism, misery, despair, want, hunger and crime, to a state of solvency, with unemployment absorbed in developing Canada's vast resources thereby wiping out causes of Bolshevism, revolution and crime, and restoring happiness and contentment to all, our "Premier" being instrumental in bringing about the Stabilization of Silver.

Sandon, a Silver-Lead-Camp, in the heart of the rich Slocan district - having produced ores running up to 13,000 ounces of silver and up to 80% lead -- . many mines in. which have each paid millions of dollars in dividends. population has dwindled from over 3000 to less than 200, and the mines all closed down tight, not even any development work being done. Under the present conditions, and, with no future to anything, it is impossible to get any monied interests interested in silver and lead properties. Real worth-while properties too, in proven ore zones, having unlimited possibilities ( noted mining men having claimed that the district so far has only been barely scratched ) and being offered at prices in accordance with the present times, and, at the present time one could get development work done for much less than half of what it would cost in normal times. What an opportunity for investment. - that is, IF, Silver and Lead will ever again be of any and at the same time affording work for some value -- ?? of the unemployed.

If something of this nature could be taken over by the Government —— in a big way —— accomplishing development of our natural resources, enriching the material wealth of our country, whilst relieving the unemployment situation. Would this not be a more satisfactory solution —— also more satisfactory to the morale of the people —— than paying out millions of dollars in 'DOLES', for, "No value whatsoever in return" ???????????
