

Sandon nicknames

The Paystreak, 22 Jan 1898: Robert Cuning “is known as the father of Sandon.”

The Paystreak, 30 Apr 1898: “The king of Sandon is bound to have the best of everything and he generally gets it.”

The Ledge, 27 Oct 1898, *The Paystreak* 29 Oct 1898 and *Mining Review*, 5 Nov 1898: Description of Sandon by P.A. O’Farrell: “J.M. Harris is the king of Sandon ... It has made him the king of Sandon.”

The Paystreak, 11 Oct 1902: “J. Morgan Harris, the Pierp Morgan of Sandon, is rubbering the Spokane fair this week.”

Enderby Press, 21 Jul 1910: “Bruce White, the silver-lead king of Sandon”

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
