The Paystreak, 15 May 1897: Fred T. Kelly leaves for Spokane, San Francisco, and southern states. To be away three months.

The Paystreak, 24 Jul 1897: Fred T. Kelly had index finger of right hand removed at Spokane.

Mining Review, 30 Oct 1897: Fred Kelly elected president of Sandon hockey club.

Mining Review, 12 Nov 1898: F.T. Kelly back from southern states.

The Ledge, 20 Jun 1912: Fred Kelly has sold his interest in the Reco hotel at Sandon to J.M. Harris.

Slocan Record, 13 Jun 1912: J.M. Harris has purchased the interests of F.T. Kelly in the Waterworks and Electric Light companies and the Reco hotel in Sandon.

The Kootenaian, 31 Jan 1929: Fred Kelly arrives in Kaslo from Seattle after father's funeral. Leaves for home in Sandon.

Slocan Enterprise, 24 Apr 1929: Fred Kelly who has spent the winter months with Mr. and Mrs. J.M. Harris, left on Wednesday for Spokane.
