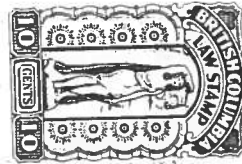

F i r s t - I HEREBY DECLARE that my true and correct name is JOHN MORGAN DAVIS, and that I was formerly a resident of Vernon Mills near Marshall, in Fauquier County, in the State of Virginia one of the United States of America, and that many years ago whilst in the west and a young man I, for no dishonourable purpose but simply to suit a fancy, proclaimed myself as bearing the surname of Harris, and by reason of the acquisition of property in that name have found it inconvenient to attempt to thereafter use my true and correct name of birth, namely, that of JOHN MORGAN DAVIS.

S e c o n d - I NOMINATE AND APPOINT my wife ALMA L. HARRIS otherwise Alma L. Davis and my niece GOLDA DAVIS POLLOCK the Executrices of this my Will and Testament.

T h i r d - I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH one-half of my estate both Real and Personal and wheresoever situated and over which I have any power of appointment to my wife ALMA L. HARRIS otherwise Alma L. Davis for her own use absolutely provided that if she shall predecease me I Give Devise and Bequeath the said one-half of my estate to her father and mother or the survivor.

AND I GIVE DEVISE AND BEQUEATH the remaining one-half of my said estate to my niece GOLDA DAVIS POLLOCK in Trust to divide equally between herself and my other nieces and nephews provided that if any of them have or shall predecease me then her or his heirs shall have and take the share which she or he which has or shall predecease me would have taken had she or he survived.

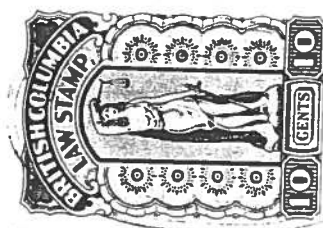
