The Paystreak, 25 Sept 1897: J.M. Harris plans on cutting off 20 feet of old rink for heating plant, which will make it too small for curling and hockey.

Mining Review, 30 Oct 1897: Big boiler from Indianapolis to heat several of JMH's buildings. Embedded in brick support at the rink.

Mining Review, 13 Nov 1897: Boiler for the heating system located in the rink.

Mining Review, 1 Oct 1898: Water system and fire protection system were separate. A third parallel pipe supplied steam heating generated by a large boiler.
