The Paystreak, 26 Sept 1896:
Waterworks tested.

The Paystreak, 24 Apr 1897: Legal ad for waterworks to divert 100 inches from Sandon creek.

Mining Review, 23 Oct 1897: New waterworks under construction. Harris' hot water apparatus arrives to heat three blocks.

Mining Review, 1 Oct 1898: Water system and fire protection system were separate. A third parallel pipe supplied steam heating generated by a large boiler.

The Ledge, 17 Apr 1902: The City of Sandon and J.M. Harris have agreed again to disagree, and as a result the snow-capped city cannot have either water or light from the local company.
