and numbered Lot Three (3), Block Four (4), Subdivision of Part of Lot Seven Hundred and Twenty-seven (727), Registered Plan Six Hundred and Nine "A" (609-A) on file in the Land Registry Office at Nelson

on the Official Plan or Survey of the said KOOTENAY DISTRICT

in the Province of British Columbia, to have and to hold the said Parcel or Lot of Land, and all and singular the premises hereby granted, with their appurtenances, unto the said JOHN MORGAN HARRIS

his heirs and assigns, for ever:
